





### Student Care Fee Subsidies

Student Care Fee Assistance (SCFA) provides fee assistance for children from lower-income working families enrolled in MSF-registered Student Care Centre (SCCs).

#### Criteria:

Child is a Singapore Citizen or a Permanent Resident (at least one immediate family member in the same household must be a Singapore Citizen)

Both you and your spouse are each working at least 56 hours a month

Child attends MSF-registered Student Care Centre Monthly household income of less than or equal to \$4,500, or monthly household income per capita of less than or equal to \$1,125
