P6 Assessment Matters

Dear Parents

We encourage our pupils to put in effective effort in their academic learning throughout the year so that they will not be unduly anxious and stressed during PSLE. We seek parents' support to monitor your children at home, ensure that they have sufficient time to study and to rest. We also seek parents' close monitoring and support to ensure that your children are not excessively engaged in online activities (gaming, social media and text messaging). Together we can support the learning and development of your children, and take care of their mental and emotional health as well.

Please be informed that in the first semester, for Term 1, Primary 6 pupils will only be given non-weighted assessments. For Term 2, there will be a **Weighted Assessment** (WA). All assessments will be conducted during curriculum hours, unless otherwise stated.

Apart from both non-weighted and weighted assessments, Primary 6 pupils will sit for Preliminary Examinations in Term 3.

Attendance during Assessments

Please note that it is important and necessary that:

- Pupils must be present for all assessments unless certified unwell by a general practitioner. The school should be informed promptly of the medical leave;
- Pupils who are absent for an assessment, including Prelims, with a medical certificate endorsed by a general practitioner may be able to sit for the assessment on another day, but the marks will not be recorded;
- Pupils who are absent for any assessment without a medical certificate endorsed by a general
 practitioner will not be able to sit for the assessment on another day and will be awarded a 'zero'
 mark; and
- For language papers (English and Mother Tongue) in the end-of-year examination, pupils should have taken at least Paper 2 to be awarded an overall assessment mark for the subject.
